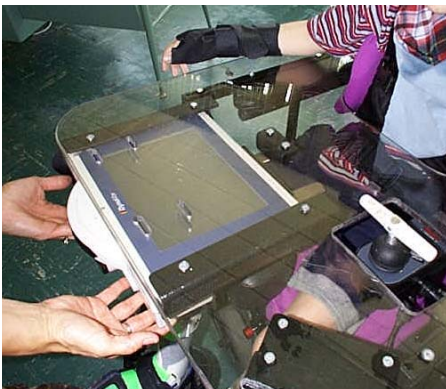


Sherry Rovig: Past Projects

Custom laptray, easel, and communication device mount



A boy in elementary school who uses a communication device needed a new mount for his system. They wanted it in a specific position, but wanted it to be able to be stored while he drove his power wheelchair. His joystick needed flexibility in positioning based on variability in his muscle control. His school team identified other needs such as the need for a removable easel.

The communication device slides in on tracks under his tray, allowing him to see it for visual scanning and operation even in the stowed position. The adjustable angle easel is removable, for when they want a flat work surface.
